Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Kent Road Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Kent Road Public School. The project will enable the school to accommodate more than 900 students in permanent facilities. The redevelopment includes 34 new classrooms, special programs spaces, a new canteen and library, new outdoor play area and multi-purpose sports court and administration facilities.

Progress summary

The Kent Road Public School upgrade is approaching an exciting milestone with the construction of new buildings about to commence as part of the main works. Approval of the State Significant Development Application was granted in late August 2019. Early works are well underway on the parts of the school being refurbished.

Main works construction commencement

Site establishment for the main works is expected to commence in September with site clearance and excavation works starting soon after.

Construction will take place between 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 8:00am and 1:00pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless approval and notification is provided.

During construction you may notice an increase in vehicles entering and leaving the site and increased noise due to construction activities. Mitigation measures will be in place to manage traffic, noise and dust levels, including hoarding, hosing down as required and deliveries will be scheduled outside of pick up and drop off times where possible.

School Infrastructure NSW will continue to work closely with the school community and neighbours to minimise project impacts where possible.
