## Removal of tower crane - Saturday 1 August 2020

The previously notified works to remove the tower crane from the Kent Road Public School upgrade construction site will now take place on Saturday 1 August. The change in date is due to forecasted poor weather this weekend.

This work will involve dismantling the tower crane within the construction site and then removing the crane in sections on heavy rigid trucks and trailers. You may notice some excess noise during these works, including the loading of trucks and vehicle movement on site. We will make every effort to minimise disruption to the community during this work.

Works will take place between 7am and 5pm. During this time additional traffic controls will be implemented to ensure the safety of pedestrians. It is expected that the works will have minimal impact on pedestrian and vehicle movements on surrounding streets.

All safety requirements and regulations will be followed to ensure the safe removal of the tower crane by licensed contractors.
