The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Kent Road Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Kent Road Public School to accommodate more than 900 students in permanent facilities. The redevelopment includes 34 new classrooms, special programs spaces, a new canteen and library, new outdoor play area and multipurpose sports court, and administration facilities.

Progress summary

The final façade installation works are nearing completion for the two new homebase blocks and the new administration block

Internal works are progressing well within the new homebase blocks with the fit-out works in the administration block following. Scaffolding removal is substantially completed enabling external works to start including the new covered outdoor learning area (COLA), access stairs and ramps as well as construction of new retaining structures and garden beds.

Next steps

Finalisation of the internal finishes, joinery installation and services fit out will continue in all new buildings.

Completion of the new COLA and external works will continue.
