Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Killara High School upgrade

A project is underway at Killara High School to deliver 15 new permanent teaching spaces and two specialist spaces.

Progress summary

The school upgrade remains on-track for completion by mid-2020.

Scaffolding has been removed from the new building, along Churchill Road.

Next steps

Work will continue over coming weeks to complete the building's façade.

Landscaping is underway behind the boundary fence along Churchill Road. Internal work is underway to fit out the building, including painting.

In the coming weeks, scaffolding and site sheds will be removed.

We will continue to work with the school community and neighbours to ensure that disruptions are minimised.
