## Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. ## Killara High School

An upgrade is underway at Killara High School. The project will deliver 17 new permanent teaching and specialist teaching spaces and upgrades to some of the school's existing core facilities.

### **Progress summary**

The new multi-storey building structure is complete. Roof installation is due to commence along with internal electrical and plumbing services installations.

#### Summer school holiday works

Works will continue over the summer holidays and will be primarily focused on internal fit-out, with hydraulic, electrical and mechanical works continuing.

External facade works will also take place, focusing on the installation of facade cladding. Scaffolding along the building is scheduled to be removed in late January 2020.

## Frequently asked questions

### What works will be completed over the holidays?

Major works during the holiday period will be primarily focused on internal fit-out with hydraulic, electrical and mechanical works being undertaken.

External façade works will also take place focusing on the installation of façade cladding.

Scaffolding along the building is scheduled to be removed in late January 2020.

## What are the construction working hours?

All works will be completed within the approved Development Application hour of Monday to Saturday between 7:00am and 5:00pm.

No works will take place on public holidays or Sundays.

# Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

Works will continue throughout the period, however no work will take place on public holidays or Sundays.

### What safety measures will be in place?

A site manager and safety coordinator will be on-site at all times during these works.

# What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Hoarding and shade cloth has been erected around the perimeter of the site. Noise and dust controls are in place to minimise the impacts on the local community.

### How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers. Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
