### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$847 million is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

### Killarney Heights Public School

An exciting upgrade is being planned for Killarney Heights Public School. The project will deliver seven new permanent teaching spaces and a special programs room.

The upgrade considered existing property and assets and the concrete dome removal is part of the project scope.

### What has been decided about the concrete dome?

The Office of Environment and Heritage has requested further assessment be undertaken for the consideration to remove the concrete dome. The removal of the concrete dome is part of the school upgrade scope of works. We will advise you of the outcome of the assessment and if there is an impact to the project.

We are committed to working with our school stakeholders to deliver the best educational outcomes for current and future school students.

## What investigations were completed by the Department's heritage consultants?

Investigations were conducted on the concrete dome at Killarney Heights Public School, including structural, hazardous materials, and heritage due diligence assessments. The outcome of these investigations deemed that the replacement of the concrete dome with state-of-the-art teaching facilities is an appropriate use of this site by the Department at Killarney Heights Public School.

## Will this impact school operations?

No. We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently. During this time we will be working collaboratively with the school community and neighbours to ensure that disruptions to school operations and the community are minimised.
