Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Killarney Heights Public School upgrade

An upgrade is underway at Killarney Heights Public School. The project will deliver:

- seven new permanent teaching spaces
- a special programs room
- removal of the concrete bini-dome.

Progress summary

The school upgrade remains on-track for completion by mid-2020.

Since Term 4, the new building has taken shape as the structure itself has been completed and the windows installed.

Work will continue on the building's façade and the internal services and electrical fit-out.

Next steps

In the coming weeks, the internal fit-out will continue, including the installation of internal walls, ceilings and floors.

A new electrical substation will also be installed near the school's entrance.

We will continue to work with the school community and neighbours to ensure that disruptions are minimised.
