When will work commence?

In late January 2019, the Office of Environment and Heritage requested further assessment of the concrete dome at Killarney Heights Public School.

The request for further assessment means that works will not commence until the department receive the outcome of the assessment.

The assessment of the concrete dome is underway and the department is awaiting that advice. We will advise of the outcome as soon as it becomes available.

What will happen now that the school term has commenced?

After the assessment of the concrete dome is completed, future works will be discussed with the Principal and staff to ensure that disruption to school operations, teaching and learning are minimised.

Is there an impact to current school operations?

No. School operations during Term 1 continue as usual.

How will you keep us updated?

We will communicate construction works with the school community and near neighbours in advance. Our priority is to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently.
