### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

An upgrade is underway at Killarney Heights Public School. The project will deliver:

- Seven new permanent teaching spaces
- A special programs room
- Removal of the concrete bini-dome.

# **Progress summary**

The upgrade at Killarney Heights Public School is progressing well with all structural works on site completed.

# Summer school holiday works

Over the summer work will continue on site to as the construction progresses to level 1. Plumbing and electrical services will be fitted as well as frames to support internal walls.

The external façade of the building will be see a significant transformation with roofing works taking place, windows installed and external cladding fitted.

Necessary safety and weather-proofing work will also take place; hydraulic and fire hydrant services will be connected to Tralee Avenue and a stormwater detention basin will be installed.

# Frequently asked questions

## What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours over the summer school holidays will be Monday to Saturday from 7:00am to 5:00pm.

No work will take place on Sundays and Public Holidays.

# Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

No work will be undertaken from Friday 20 December 2019 to Sunday 5 January 2020 inclusive.

### What safety measures will be in place?

The safety of the community is our highest priority. All work will be undertaken in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulation. The perimeter of the site will be secured when it is vacant, equipment will be removed where possible, or safely stowed and locked away. Access to the scaffolding surrounding the new building will also be cordoned-off.

# What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Over the summer break, noise and dust impacts will be kept to a minimum. While excavation work is being completed, dust suppression methods will be used.

### How will traffic be managed?

Traffic control measures will be in place where required to ensure the safety of the community. While work is underway on Tralee Avenue, traffic management will be implemented to minimise disruption to the local community.
