Kingscliff High School Project update | December 2023

Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a historic \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Kingscliff High School is being upgraded to provide new permanent classrooms and core facilities. The upgraded school will include a new Creative and Performing Arts building (CAPA), a new library, a new senior learning environment, refurbished hospitality facilities and general learning spaces, a new sports pavilion, and new landscaping.

Progress update

The new library, administration building extension and Seniors' Learning Hub have been completed and handed over to the school. Works are progressing on refurbishing classrooms in Building C, as well as the Building G kitchen and new Creative and Performing Arts Building O. Some landscaping work has commenced.

Next steps

During the summer school holidays we will continue to work on Building C West, Building G kitchens and the Creative and Performing Arts Building, which we expect to have finished and ready for use by Term 2 2024.

We will also start other landscaping works including beautifying the front entrance of the school and planting koala feed trees behind Building C. We also expect to start work on the new staff carpark.


