The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

Kingscliff High School is being upgraded to provide new permanent learning spaces and core facilities. The scope of work includes a new Creative and Performing Arts building (CAPA), a new library, a new senior learning environment, refurbished hospitality facilities and general learning spaces, and a new sports pavilion.

Progress update

The new library opened in March 2023. The library has state of the art equipment and excellent student facilities. The Covered Outdoor Learning Area (COLA) is also complete and being enjoyed by the students.

Both the construction of the Creative and Performing Arts building (CAPA) and the extension to the Administration Building A have commenced. Works are progressing on the refurbishment of the former library into the Seniors Learning space.

Next steps

The program of works over the coming months will include progressing the CAPA, completing the fit out of the Seniors Learning space and the extension to the Administration building.
