Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a historic \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Progress update

During the school holidays work progressed on, Buildings O, G and C, and work commenced on the new staff carpark. Landscaping works and beautification of the front entry is progressing. In addition, we completed planting of 176 koala feed trees as part of the Tweed Coast comprehensive koala plan of management. These trees will provide future habitat for local koalas.

Next steps

Refurbishment of the kitchens in Building G is expected to be completed in mid-February, and the new Creative and Performing Arts (CAPA) Building O is on track for completion in March 2024. Work will then commence to refurbish the remaining classrooms and staff studies in Building C. Landscaping work will continue and is expected to be complete in term 2 2024.

Work on the carpark will include some earthworks requiring the use of a vibrating roller. Stage 1 of the earthworks will commence Monday 19 February and continue intermittently for 3 weeks. We will advise you of the timing of stage 2 of the earthworks when it is confirmed. This work is expected to be noisy and may create some local vibration. Residents adjacent to the school will be contacted directly regarding these earthworks.

Later in the term we will commence work on new footpaths on Cambridge Court, Yale Street and Oxford Street. Residents on these streets will be contacted prior to this work commencing to discuss specific details of the work.

Working hours

Construction hours are 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised.
