Works notification | 28 March 2024

Public domain pedestrian infrastructure and line marking works Kingscliff High School

As part of the upgrade to Kingscliff High School, we will be undertaking work to construct new footpaths, carparking and line marking on Cambridge Court, Yale Street, Oxford Street, Dinsey Street and Vulcan Street.

The map (right) shows the location of the work to be undertaken.

Stage 1 of the work will commence on Cambridge Court and Yale Street on 3 April and continue for approximately 2 weeks, weather permitting. Following the completion of Stage 1 work, Stage 2 will commence at the intersection of Oxford Street and Cudgen Road for a further 2 weeks, approximately, weather permitting.

The balance of work will follow sequentially with an expected duration of approximately 12 weeks.

All works are subject to fair weather, start dates and durations may vary.

Lane closures will be managed with traffic controllers and signage. Residents' driveways will not be affected and they will have access to their driveways at all times.

Construction working hours

Approved working hours are 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised.
