Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

Kingscliff High School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities. The scope of work includes a new library, new senior learning environment, refurbished hospitality facilities, creative and performing arts building and new sports and PE pavilion.

Progress summary

Site establishment for early works (Stage 1) to construct the new sports and PE pavilion started during the Term 1 school holidays.

Early works were put on hold in late April 2020 due to the discovery of stone fragments while digging a services trench. The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) has investigated the find and determined that there has been no breach of statutory Aboriginal heritage protection requirements. We are working with relevant stakeholders to ensure we continue to meet Aboriginal heritage protection obligations.

A request for tenders (RFT) has been issued for the main construction works (Stage 2) and responses are due in August 2020.

Next steps

- Continue working with Aboriginal heritage stakeholders.
- Start construction of sports pavilion.
- Evaluate tender submissions and appoint a main works building contractor.
