Project update

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

Kingscliff High School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities.

The scope of work includes a new creative and performing arts building, new library, new senior learning environment, refurbished hospitality facilities and general learning spaces, and new sports pavilion.

Early works update

Early works at the school were finished in late 2020 and are the new facilities are now in use by the school. A new sports and physical education pavilion was built adjacent to the existing netball courts. The architecturally designed building includes change rooms and bathroom facilities, storage and a covered outdoor learning space.

March 2021

Main works update

- A construction contractor has been appointed for the main works and is now working with the school to finalise the detailed design for the upgrade.
- We are finalising the planning approval documents and reports required for a State Significant Development (SSD).
- The SSD application will be lodged with the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment soon and will be placed on public exhibition for community comments and feedback.
- We are also conducting a Review of Environmental Factors which will enable us to progress extensions to the existing administration building while the SSD application is being finalised, lodged and assessed.

Project timeline

The timeline for completion of main works has been extended to cater for additional time needed to achieve planning approval and meet conditions of consent. It is anticipated that the upgrade of Kingscliff High School will now be completed by late 2022.

To ensure the school gains the benefits of new facilities as soon as possible, the upgrade will be delivered progressively.

In addition to the early works already delivered, further new facilities will be ready for use by the school in late 2021, with the remainder being ready for use progressively throughout 2022.
