The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

Kingscliff High School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities. The scope of work includes a new library, new senior learning environment, refurbished hospitality facilities, creative and performing arts building and new sports and PE pavilion.

Progress summary

The concrete floor slab and frame for the new sports and PE pavilion is now complete. Tenders have closed for construction of the main works and School Infrastructure NSW is evaluating submissions.

Work is continuing to prepare planning approval documents for lodgement with the NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment. The State Significant Development Application will be exhibited for the community to review and comment.

School holiday works

Construction of the new sports and PE pavilion will continue during the Term 3 school holidays and into early Term 4. Activities will include:

- Installation of metal roof sheets, flashing, gutters, downpipes and water drainage system
- Internal fit out of new change rooms and toilets.

Work that requires excavation or ground disturbance will be monitored by a heritage consultant and a representative of the Local Aboriginal Land Council. If any objects of potential cultural significance are discovered work will halt immediately and we will work through the required Aboriginal heritage protection processes.

Work will take place between 7:00am and 6:00pm, Monday to Friday and 8:00am to 1:00pm on Saturdays.
