

Kingscliff Public School

Works Notification | 1 May 2023

Kingscliff Public School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities to cater for enrolment growth in the area.

Civil Works

This notification is an update to the previous notices that provided information about the sewer diversion works at Kingscliff Public School. The sewer diversion works commenced on the 13 March and due to unexpected rock found in this area, will now conclude on or before the 19 May 2023.

Road Closures

Due to the nature of the works, car and pedestrian access will impact traffic and pedestrian access on Sutherland Street (refer map on next page) from 15 March until 19 May 2023. A certified traffic controller will be in place from 6:30am to 7:00pm, weekdays during these dates. There will be no impact to weekend traffic.

- One lane access along Sutherland Street will start from 6:30am to 9:30am to allow for school drop off.
- From 9:30am until 2pm, Sutherland Street, between Moss St and Hungerford Lane, will be closed, and detours will be in place.
- From 2pm to 6:30pm traffic will have one lane access to allow for school pick up.
- From 6:30pm to 6:30am, Sutherland Street will have both lanes open.
- As the footpath will be affected, all pedestrians will be escorted around the detours by a suitably qualified traffic controller.

Noise and Road Resurfacing

Due to the unexpected hard rock found in this area, the excavation works will be noisy. Rock breaking will only occur during authorised hours of operation. We will try and minimise the amount of disruption as best we can.

Additional works will also include road resurfacing, line marking, reconstructing walkways, kerbs and planting grass.
