Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a historic \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

The upgrade to Kingscliff Public School includes replacement of all classrooms including demountable buildings, a new library and administration building, an extended hall with new canteen, new outdoor spaces, and a redeveloped school entry.

Progress Update

Students and teachers have moved into the new buildings and facilities in the southern part of the site shown in the red outline over the page, and we are now undertaking the final phase of the project, shown in the blue outline over the page.

Levelling and compaction of soil to create a pad for Building 1 is now complete and work has started on the building foundations and blockwork walls.

Next Steps

In the lead up to the Christmas break, work will continue on the blockwork walls for Building 1. Cutting of blocks will be done using a wet saw to manage dust. From around 20 December 2023, weather and other factors permitting, and into January 2024, we will be pouring the concrete ground slab for Building 1.

During concrete works, multiple concrete trucks will enter and leave the site each day through the construction access roads and concrete pumps will be in operation. We will aim to have all noisy works completed by 4 pm, however the approved construction hours are up to 6 pm on weekdays. Traffic management will be in place as required to maintain safety during heavy vehicle movements.

Remaining groundworks at the site, including levelling and compacting the ground for the play area and sports court, will be done using a smooth, non-vibrating roller to minimise impacts on neighbouring residents. Where more fill is needed, self-compacting aggregate will be used so that only a small non-vibrating roller is required for compaction.


Working hours

No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised.
