

Kingscliff Public School

Works notification | 10 May 2023

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

As part of the ongoing upgrades to Kingscliff Public School, a small remnant of asbestos was removed from the school during the April 2023 school holidays.

A small piece of suspected non-friable asbestos was found during the excavation of a pit. Testing conducted by an independent hygienist, confirmed that the material was non-friable asbestos with no evidence of asbestos in the surrounding soil.

The area was out of bounds to the staff and all work was completed by Monday 24 April 2023, outside of the school term.

The area has been remediated in accordance with the Builder's SSDA Management Plan, SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines. Clean fill has been used to fill the pit and grass has been planted to cover the area, with air monitoring as required.

Please be assured the removal of this material did not pose a risk to students, staff, or the community. The school has received a clearance certificate and the area has reopened for construction to continue.

We will keep you informed if further material is found which requires removal.
