

# Kingscliff Public School

Works notification | 21 November 2023

As part of ongoing works on the older part of Kingscliff Public School, there will be a number of activities ongoing within the school over the remainder of 2023.

## Construction update

Work taking place at the site now and over the coming months includes remediation of an area where new buildings will be constructed, and establishment of foundations for the new buildings. Activities, include:

- Soil compaction using machinery which rolls and vibrates
- Insertion of screw piles
- Construction and backfill of retaining walls
- Concrete pours
- Establishment of the site compound.

## Ongoing site remediation

As outlined in a previous [works notification](#) issued on 3 November 2023, works are continuing to remediate soil in an area where fragments of asbestos containing material were found.

All work is being carried out by licensed and accredited contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists, in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines. Following remediation, the area will be inspected by the occupational hygienist and a clearance certificate provided. We will continue to monitor for any unknown in-ground asbestos and notify the community of future removal works if required.

## Noise, dust and vibration monitoring

All work at the site is being undertaken in line with the conditions of our State Significant Development Application (SSDA) and management plans.

- Noise and vibration monitoring is in place and will continue throughout this phase of work. There have been no exceedances recorded.
- Dust suppression controls are in place, including on site water truck and site environmental controls. Dust will reduce significantly once soil compaction is complete.

We would like to reassure the community that any increase in noise, dust and vibration observed at the site is within allowable levels and is safe for humans and structures.

## Working hours

All work will take place during approved hours of **7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 4pm on Saturdays**. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise notified.
