

Kingscliff Public School

Works notification | 11 October 2023

As part of the ongoing upgrades to Kingscliff Public School, the following works will be undertaken.

Asbestos removal

Work to remove asbestos containing material in the ceiling of block C was unable to be completed over the school holidays.

This work will now take place outside of school hours on **Saturday 14 October**.

The material has been confirmed as bonded asbestos, which means it is attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled under light pressure.

Licensed asbestos contractors will enter the site via School Lane and will work between **07.30 am and 04.00 pm**. Additional safety measures and air monitoring will be in place before works start.

The area is currently cordoned off within an unoccupied worksite and is inaccessible to students and staff.

These areas will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

All asbestos-containing material will be removed in accordance with the advice of the independent hygienist.

Testing will be completed to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The construction contractor will receive a clearance certificate following remediation.

The health, safety and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority, and we will continue to keep the community updated.
