Kingscliff Public School Works notification | 27 May 2024

We are upgrading Kingscliff Public School to provide new permanent learning spaces and core facilities to cater to the growing local community.

Extended working hours

To ensure that work at the Kingscliff Public School can be completed in a timely manner, we will be extending Saturday working hours until the end of July 2024.

Saturday work hours have been extended to 7am to 3pm (*previously 8am to 1pm*) for the period 1 June to 27 July 2024 inclusive.

There is no change to Monday to Friday working hours, which remain 7am to 6pm. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise notified.

The proposed work to be undertaken during the extended working hours, will be limited to fit-out and finishing (plastering, tiling, cabinetry), and commissioning of services only.

The work will not include any high impact or high noise activities.

Should any other works be necessary during this time, residents will be advised prior to it commencing.
