

Kingscliff Public School upgrade

Works notification | 24 July 2024

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to upgrade Kingscliff Public School to provide new permanent classrooms and core facilities to cater to the growing community.

Footpath works

As part of the upgrade to Kingscliff Public School new footpaths are being laid on the eastern side of Orient Street. A recent inspection of the footpath by the Tweed Shire Council found that some sections of the footpath were required to be rectified.

Work to replace the sections of the footpath on Orient Street will take place during the week of the 22 July 2024, weather permitting. This work will be undertaken in 2 stages and will require partial lane closures on Orient Street and School Lane. Residents' driveways will not be affected by this work and residents will have access at all times.

Traffic controls, including signage will be in place throughout the works to ensure the safety of pedestrians and traffic and to manage Pick Up and Drop Off traffic at peak times during the morning and afternoon hours.

Construction work hours

Approved working hours are 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised.
