Works notification

Kingscliff Public School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities to cater for enrolment growth in the area. The scope of work includes replacement of all classrooms, including demountable buildings, a new library, an extended hall and new canteen, new outdoor spaces and a redeveloped school entry

Upcoming work

From Monday 8 February 2021 we will be conducting bore hole testing at Kingscliff Public School as part of our site investigations for the school upgrade.

Seven bore holes will be made across the Kingscliff Public School site as indicated in the image to the right. We will use a truck-mounted drill rig to make these bore holes, which is roughly as loud as a commercial lawnmower. The bore holes will be approximately 10 cm wide and up to four metres deep.

This work will involve four contractors being on site and will be completed in a day. Test areas will be cordoned off during drilling to ensure student and public safety.

Over the coming months, there will also be site visits to Kingscliff Public School by our project team and contractors such as architects and engineers who will be conducting a range of site investigations as part of their early planning and design work.
