Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

Kingscliff Public School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities to cater to the growing community. The scope of work includes replacement of all classrooms including demountable buildings, a new library, an extended hall with new canteen, new outdoor spaces and a redeveloped school entry.

To ensure the school gains the benefits of new facilities as soon as possible, the upgrade is being delivered in stages.

Progress summary

The Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) has approved the State Significant Development (SSD) application for the remainder of the upgrade at Kingscliff Primary School. The Conditions of Approval can be found on the DPE major projects website <https://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/major-projects/project/38056>. School Infrastructure NSW now has all the necessary planning consents for the upgrade project.

Next steps

Works are continuing on the new administration building, which is being delivered under a Review of Environmental Factors (REF) planning pathway. Works will start on the remainder of the upgrade in the coming weeks. This will include construction of new learning spaces, a new library, new outdoor spaces and a redeveloped school entry. We will keep the community updated with further details prior to construction commencing.
