Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

Kingscliff Public School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities to cater for enrolment growth in the area. The scope of work includes replacement of all classrooms including demountable buildings, a new library, an extended hall with new canteen, new outdoor spaces and a redeveloped school entry.

To ensure the school gains the benefits of new facilities as soon as possible, the upgrade is being delivered in stages.

Progress update

In October 2021, works on the administration building were paused as a result of an unexpected artefact find on site. Following the discovery of these artefacts, School Infrastructure NSW were required to apply for an Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit (AHIP) with Heritage NSW in order for works to continue.

Heritage NSW have now approved the AHIP and the administration building works restarted in late November 2021.

The State Significant Development (SSD) application for the remainder of the upgrade is currently being assessed by the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE). Construction will start following the determination of the SSD application by DPE.
