Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

Kingscliff Public School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities to cater for future enrolment growth in the area. The scope of work includes replacement of all classrooms including demountable buildings, a new library, an extended hall with new canteen, new play spaces and a redeveloped school entry.

Progress summary

External work to extend the existing school hall and provide a new student canteen is well progressed. Demolition has finished, a new concrete floor slab has been poured, and the steel frame has been put up.

Tenders have closed for main works and School Infrastructure NSW is evaluating the submissions. Work is continuing to prepare planning approval documents for lodgement with the NSW Department of Industry, Planning and Environment. The State Significant Development Application will be exhibited for the community to review and comment.

School holiday works

Early works will continue during the Term 3 school holidays and into early Term 4. Activities will include:

- Brickwork for new walls
- Installation of metal roofing sheets
- Internal fit out of the new canteen including cabinetry and joinery
- Electrical and plumbing work
- Pouring concrete for a new footpath.
