Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$847 million is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Kingswood High School upgrade

The Kingswood High School project will provide a new hall with modern facilities for the school. This includes a multipurpose indoor sports and performance area, health/PE, performing arts learning unit and a school stage.

Construction of the new hall is proposed to start in early 2019, subject to planning approvals. The new hall will be open and ready for students to use by early 2020.

Progress summary

The schematic design has been finalised and the design and construct contract is out to tender.

The development application has been submitted to the local council and is now on public exhibition.

Next steps

The outcome of the development application will be determined and early works will commence in early 2019.
