Progress summary

Works are progressing well on the Kingswood High School upgrade. The structural steel framework for the hall is completed and scaffolding has been installed in preparation for internal works to begin on the mezzanine floor.

Term 1 holiday works

Construction works will be undertaken at Kingswood High School during the Term 1 school holidays. These will include roofing works for the new multipurpose school hall and the commencement of external paving works.

Work hours will be from Monday to Friday, 7:00am -5:00pm and Saturdays, 8:00am - 1:00pm. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless notified. The community will be kept informed of any changes to the approved working hours.

We are here to make sure this work is carried out safely and efficiently. During this time we will be working collaboratively with the school community and neighbours to ensure disruptions are minimised to the wider community.

Frequently asked questions

What is being delivered?

A project is underway at Kingswood High School to deliver a new multipurpose school hall. This hall will feature an indoor sports and performance area, health, physical education and performing arts learning units, and a school stage.

What are the construction working hours?

Work hours will be from Monday to Friday, 7:00am - 5:00pm and Saturdays, 8:00am - 1:00pm. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless notified. The community will be kept informed of any changes to the approved working hours.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of our students, staff, community and workers is our highest priority. Temporary fencing has been installed around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

In line with the Construction Management Plan the contractor will continue to implement dust and noise control measures.

Dust is minimised with hoarding and ensuring all vehicles exiting the site are clean. Dust is also controlled by spraying water during earth works whenever permissible in line with water-use restrictions.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers. Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
