Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Progress summary

An upgrade is underway at Kingswood High School. This project will deliver a new hall with modern facilities for the school. This includes a multipurpose indoor sports and performance area, health/PE, performing arts learning unit and a school stage.

Current works include the excavation of footing beams and the installation of piers. The ground concrete slab is scheduled for completion in late 2019.

Summer school holiday works

Over the summer school holidays, works will continue at Kingswood High School with the installation of the steel structure for the new multipurpose hall.

Construction work will take place Monday to Friday, 7.00am to 6.00pm, and Saturday from 8.00am to 1.00pm. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

Traffic control and security measures will also be in place where required for the safety of the community.

We are here to make sure this work is carried out safely and efficiently. During this time we will be working collaboratively with the school community and neighbours to ensure disruptions are minimised to the wider community.

Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

During the summer school holidays the primary steel structure for the new multipurpose school hall is scheduled to be installed.

What are the construction working hours?

Work hours will be from Monday to Friday, 7.00am - 6.00pm and Saturdays, 7.00am - 1.00pm. No works will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

Construction works at Kingswood High School will cease at close of business on 20 December 2019 and resume on 6 January 2020.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing has been installed around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

In line with the Construction Management Plan, the contractor will continue to implement dust and noise control measures.

Dust is minimised with hoarding and ensuring all vehicles exiting the site are clean. Dust is also controlled by spraying water during earth works whenever permissible under water-use restrictions.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers. Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
