As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$3.5 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

These funds will help to upgrade Kingswood Public School to deliver new facilities.

Kingswood Public School upgrade

Planning is continuing for an upgrade to Kingswood Public School. The project will deliver new permanent classrooms to replace the current demountable classrooms.

Progress summary

Architects and engineers will be appointed in May 2024 to finalise the masterplan and further develop the design. Doing so means that we consider the needs of the local area now and into the future and ensure the right school facilities are designed for the community.

We are working to deliver this upgrade to Kingswood Public School as quickly as possible.
