# Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world-class public education.

These funds will help to upgrade Kingswood Public School to deliver new facilities.

# **Project overview**

The upgrade will include a new single storey classroom building containing 8 classrooms and 2 commons learning spaces (for multipurpose learning) to replace the existing demountables. The upgrade also includes walkways, landscaping and minor utility services works.

### Progress update

The design has been developed for the new building in consultation with a Project Reference Group (PRG), which includes representatives from the community and educational leadership in the region.

We have shared an image of the artist impression on the first page and look forward to sharing more images with the community at an information session on 22 May 2025.

The tender evaluation process to engage a building contractor, who will finalise the design and construct the upgrade works is progressing and expected to be awarded shortly.

The planning approval pathway for this upgrade is via a Review of Environmental Factors (REF), which assesses the likely impacts of the proposed project. The REF has been submitted and we expect to receive planning determination by mid-2025.

## Next steps

- The timeline for works will be confirmed once a building contractor has been engaged.
- The building contractor will finalise the detail design and begin site establishment to support construction commencement (anticipated in mid-2025).
- As the project progresses, we will share more information with the community.
