

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. The budget includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Ku-ring-gai High School upgrade

A project is underway at Ku-ring-gai High School. The project will involve construction of a new multipurpose hall and refurbishment of some of the school's teaching spaces.

Progress summary

The design is completed for the multipurpose hall. A development application and preparation for the construction tender is underway.

Next steps

- Site signage will be installed at site
- A development application will be lodged with the local council
- Early works will start in late 2018.
