Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Ku-ring-gai High School upgrade

A major project is underway to upgrade Ku-ring-gai High School. This project will deliver:

- a new multipurpose hall
- refurbishment of 15 of the school's existing learning spaces

Progress summary

- 12 of the refurbished learning spaces have been handed over to the school to use
- internal fit out of the multi-purpose hall is nearly finished

Next steps

Work activities for the remainder of Term 2 will include:

- fit out and handover of the remaining 3 refurbished learning spaces
- finish landscaping of external areas
- finish fit out, flooring and line marking in the multipurpose hall
- commissioning and handover of the multipurpose hall
