

Kyeemagh Public School

Works notification

July 2020

School Infrastructure NSW is redeveloping Kyeemagh Public School to provide additional new permanent learning spaces and upgraded core facilities to meet the school's enrolment growth. As part of the initial construction works to prepare for construction of the upgrade to begin, ground remediation work will take place within the construction site.

Ground remediation work inside the construction site

Following site investigations during early works, in ground remediation work is required to remove bonded asbestos, nickel and hydro carbon within the construction site for Kyeemagh Public School.

Bonded asbestos means it is attached to other materials, such as cement or vinyl floor tiles and cannot be crumbled by light pressure.

Safety measures have been put in place to ensure there is no risk to students, staff or the local community. The construction site is separated by hoarding and a fence around the parameter. The area has been secured and appropriate control and monitoring measures will be installed. No asbestos containing material will be removed during school hours.

The material will be removed by licensed removal contractors. The works will be conducted in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW requirements including the following precautionary measures:

- Isolation of the work area
- Monitoring, testing and clearance certification by an independent consultant hygienist.

In line with the current *NSW Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Construction Work Days Order 2020)*, during the COVID-19 pandemic, School Infrastructure NSW construction sites can operate on weekends and public holidays. This is to allow workers to abide by social distancing rules while on construction sites by distributing building work across the week. Under this order, the material will be removed, weather and site conditions permitting, by a licensed asbestos removal contractor between 7:00am – 6:00pm on the following dates:

Week 1	Saturday 1 August and Sunday 2 August 2020
Week 2	Saturday 8 August and Sunday 9 August 2020
Week 3	Saturday 15 August and Sunday 16 August 2020
Week 4	Saturday 22 August and Sunday 23 August 2020

There may be increased noise, vibration and dust as a part of this work. We will ensure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and disruptions are minimised where possible.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school local community is our highest priority. Please be assured that the removal of this material will not be a risk to the local community. Thank you for your patience and cooperation during these important works.
