The stage two works, including the new multicourt sports space, hall, canteen and covered outdoor learning spaces are expected to be ready for use by students and staff in early 2022.

Summer holiday works

Over the summer holiday break, work will continue across the site to complete the project. Upcoming construction work includes:

- final joinery and furnishing fit out
- external landscaping
- installation of footpath and a driveway to a new staff car park on Beehag Street.

Commissioning and handover of services to the school will take place in early 2022.

Public domain footpath works

The installation of a new footpath and driveway on Beehag Street is expected to take place in mid-December. During this work there will be concrete pours, new road surfacing and minor excavation work.

Traffic management and alternative footpath routes will be in place where required for the safety of the local community and workers.

Frequently asked questions

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

The contractor will continue work as required throughout the Christmas and New Year period, in line with the approved development application. No work will take place on public holidays.
