Kyeemagh Public SchoolWorks notification

A project is underway to redevelop Kyeemagh Public School to provide new and improved facilities.

Works to upgrade the electrical substation and sewer connection were previously advised to take place in January 2021. These works have been rescheduled to take place in March and April 2021.

Electrical upgrade construction works

An upgrade of the electrical network in Jacobson Avenue, Kyeemagh, is planned to start from Monday 1 March 2021 and is expected to take approximately 4 weeks to complete, subject to weather conditions.

It is expected that two scheduled power outages will occur at a later date, after the initial works take place. At this stage we do not know the exact dates and times, however the electrical subcontractor, Connect Infrastructure, will notify impacted residents. If you are a registered life support customer, you will have received a separate notification from Connect Infrastructure to notify you that your power supply should not be interrupted. Please contact Connect Infrastructure if you have any questions about your power supply during this work.

This upgrade will require construction activity on the school side of Jacobson Avenue, near Tancred Avenue, Kyeemagh. During this time, you may experience minor construction noise, some impact to traffic and a mobile plant operating in the area.

Traffic management will be in place along Jacobson Avenue to safely direct pedestrians and traffic.

Sewer connection works

Works to upgrade the sewer connection are expected to take place in late March and early April 2021 for 7 days. A notification to advise the exact dates will be provided before works start.

Works are scheduled to take place on Jacobson Avenue (opposite the school). Works will take place across the footpath and road to allow a new connection to the existing sewer main across the road.

There will be no interruption to sewerage provision for Kyeemagh residents.



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Construction hours

Works will take place from 7am to 5pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise notified.
