Progress summary

The school canteen, hall and covered outdoor learning spaces are now finished and are ready for use by students and staff.

Works will continue on the multi-court sports space and external landscaping around the school. These works are expected to be completed in early 2022.

Traffic management around the school

During the final works, traffic management and alternative footpath routes will be in place where required for the safety of the local community and workers.
