## Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

#### **Project overview**

School Infrastructure NSW is redeveloping Kyeemagh Public School to bring students new and improved facilities and support the growing student community. The project will deliver:

- new flexible learning spaces
- a new library
- a new hall
- new amenities
- a new canteen
- a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- a new staff/administration area.

#### **Progress summary**

The building structure is now complete and work on the external facade including brickwork has started. Work to install roofing and internal services, such as electrical, mechanical and plumbing, are currently underway.

#### **Next steps**

Work will continue on the roofing, external brickwork, cladding and installation of internal services.

Once the externals of the building are complete, work to the internal fit out, including walls and interior finishes, will start.

Works to upgrade the electrical substation and a sewer connection were notified to take place over the summer holidays. These works have been postponed and will take place in March and April 2021. Separate notifications will be shared before related construction activities start.

In the upcoming months, work will take place to upgrade footpaths, plus install new pedestrian crossings and refuge islands in public domain areas near the school. We will provide further information prior to these works starting.
