Construction of the Kyeemagh Public School upgrade is progressing well and we are now ready to pour the ground-level concrete slabs. We expect three major concrete pours to take place at Kyeemagh Public School over the next four weeks, weather permitting.

Schedule of works

Concrete pours are currently scheduled for the below dates. Dates are subject to change due to weather.

- Friday 16 October 2020
- Wednesday 21 October 2020
- Monday 26 October 2020

Due to the nature of concrete pours, works will start from 7am and are expected to take 11 hours.

There will be increased truck movement along Jacobson Avenue during these works, including during drop off and potentially pick up times.

Parents and carers are encouraged to use the kiss and drop zone on Beehag Street on these dates.

To ensure the safety of students, staff, the local community and our site workers, traffic management is implemented as required. This includes the use of onsite traffic control personnel to manage entry and exit of construction vehicles. Site vehicles must give way to pedestrians at all times.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.
