

Kyeemagh Public School

Works notification

3 September 2020

Dear parents, carers and neighbours,

During construction works at Kyeemagh Public School asbestos containing material was found in the ground within the construction area that is fenced off. The material has been confirmed as bonded asbestos which means it is attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled by light pressure.

Safety measures and monitoring have been put in place to ensure there is no risk to students, staff or the local community, including North Brighton Preschool.

This area will be remediated on Saturday 5 September 2020 between 8:00am and 1:00pm in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW regulations. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

Testing will be completed to ensure the area has been fully remediated.

If further material is found that needs to be remediated, it will be done outside of school and preschool hours, in line with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW regulations.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.
