### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

### **Project overview**

A project is underway to upgrade Lake Cathie Public School. The upgrade will include:

- 17 new flexible learning spaces including two support unit classrooms
- a new school hall
- the existing school hall will be re-purposed into a new library and special programs unit
- a new bus bay
- landscaping.

### **Progress Summary**

Works are nearing completion with the new school entrance and 15 new classrooms in operation since Day 1 Term 1, 2021. The new library and bus bay are completed and have been in operation since Term 2 2021.

14 demountable classrooms have been removed, one demountable classroom will remain in the school until construction is finished in late 2021.

- internal fit out of the two support unit classrooms
- landscaping.

#### Change in construction hours

The NSW Government has recently passed legislation to allow construction hours to be extended outside of those specified in the development consent conditions (Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development-Construction Work Days) Order (No 2) 2021) to protect the health, safety and welfare of construction workers and our community during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The new construction hours are:

- 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday
- 7 am to 5 pm Saturday
- 9 am to 5 pm Sunday.

Work completed on a Sunday is restricted to certain activities to minimise noise and impact to the community. No work will occur on public holidays.
