

Lennox Head Public School relocation and new public preschool

Project update | September 2024



Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

We are currently planning for a relocated Lennox Head Public School on a new site. The project will provide more permanent classrooms to cater for growth in the local area, and new core school facilities including a hall, library, canteen, and outdoor areas. A new public preschool will also be built on the same site to provide the local community with expanded access to early childhood education.

Progress update

- The concept design for the new facilities was presented to the community at [information sessions in June 2024](#).
- We are now progressing the design to address planning and site requirements in consultation with school leadership, staff and other stakeholders.
- Through a structured consultation process, school representatives are providing input on furniture, joinery, fittings, equipment and finishes for the classrooms and other school spaces.

Next steps

- Finalise the design drawings and other specialist reports that are needed as part of the planning application for the project.
- Finalise and lodge the planning application.
