Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project is underway to provide more permanent classrooms for the local community by relocating Lennox Head Public School to new facilities on a new site. A new public preschool will also be built on the same site to provide expanded access to early childhood education.

Planning application on public exhibition

The planning application for the project, known as a Review of Environmental Factors (REF), is currently on public exhibition and will be available to view at the NSW Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure Division 5.1 planning portal until Wednesday 16 July 2025.

Any comments on the proposal may be lodged through the Planning Portal by no later than Wednesday 16 July 2025.

Next steps

When the public exhibition period for the planning application ends, responses will be reviewed and considered as part of the REF process. The REF will be assessed by the department's Planning Assessment team who will determine the outcome of the proposal.
