

Lennox Head Public School relocation and new public preschool

Project update | March 2025



Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The relocation of Lennox Head Public School to new facilities on a new site will provide more permanent classrooms to cater for growth in the local area, and new core school facilities including a hall, library, canteen, and outdoor areas. A new public preschool will also be built on the same site to provide the local community with expanded access to early childhood education.

Progress summary

- After working with a range of stakeholders to finalise the proposed design of the new school, we are now in the final stages of preparing the planning application for the project.
- We are also getting ready to issue a request for tenders from building contractors.

Next steps

- Once the planning application is complete, it will be placed on public exhibition.
- Project documentation, including the architectural design drawings, landscaping plan, proposed access and transport arrangements, and environmental impact assessment reports, will be available online for the community to view.
- During the exhibition period, we will hold drop-in information sessions where the community will be able to view the school design and speak to the project team.
