During the Term 3 school holidays we will be undertaking planned work at Lennox Head Public School to improve the playground and carry out some required maintenance. Work is expected to commence on Tuesday 29 September 2020 and, weather permitting, will be finished by 12 October 2020.

Laying of turf

Approximately 1,000 square metres of new turf will be laid at the school. Work will include spreading top soil and laying new turf across the prepared area. Turf will be delivered through the Mackney Lane entrance.

Painting and maintenance

We will also be repainting weatherboard and repairing window sills on Blocks A and H.

Working hours

Work will take place between 7:00am and 5:00pm on weekdays. There will be no work on weekends or public holidays.



Aboriginal heritage protection

This work will be conducted in compliance with the conditions of an Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit that has been granted for the long term maintenance program at the school. Registered Aboriginal Parties (RAPs) have been invited to undertake community collection prior to turf being laid to ensure that any objects of potential Aboriginal cultural heritage significance can be identified and protected. Any artefacts collected will be temporarily retained in a locked and secure storage location on site for future reburial on site. Any ground disturbing work will be monitored by a heritage consultant and a representative of the Local Aboriginal Land Council.
