

How standardised classroom layouts work in practice




Standardised design for a school learning hub, featuring 4 learning spaces and a learning commons.


The design is modified to suit the school context outlined in the education rationale. Schools can include practical activity areas or other multi-purpose spaces that support collaboration, preparation or sensory needs.

Furniture settings are selected to align to local teaching and learning requirements. Furniture selection is supported by professional learning and other resources.

From a 2D plan to a flexible modern classroom, ready for students to engage in their learning activities.













Finalisation of the schematic design for the new facilities. As the design evolves into more detail, there may be some differences compared to what has previously been shared.




Once the schematic design is finalised, we will submit a Development Application (DA) to Council. The application will be exhibited for submissions and the determination of DA can take up to 12 months.



The tender process to appoint a contractor to the project will begin in mid-2024. Once the Development Application and contractor appointment is finalised, an indicative timeline for the project will be available.
