Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The upgrade for Leppington Public School is in progress and will be delivered in 2 stages. The first stage of the upgrade will include 20 new permanent classrooms, 3 support learning classrooms, a new hall, a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA) and an upgrade and refurbishment of the administration facilities and library.
