

Leppington Public School upgrade and new public preschool

Works notification | 30 October 2025

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, Leppington Public School is being upgraded with new classrooms and support learning spaces, a new staff car park and a new public preschool.

Concrete pours from Friday 31 October 2025

The first section of the concrete slab for the new hall is scheduled to be poured on Friday 31 October, weather permitting.

From 18 November 2025, work will begin on pouring the Level 1 and Level 2 slabs, as well as the stairs for the new classroom building. These works are expected to be completed by 19 December 2025, subject to weather and site conditions.

What to expect

- All works will take place within the established construction compound (please see map on the next page).
- There will be an increased number of trucks entering and exiting the site to maintain the supply of concrete.
- Access for all construction-related vehicles will be via the site entry gate on Rickard Road.
- Traffic control will be in place to direct trucks as they enter and exit the site, to minimise traffic impacts and ensure the safety of the community.
- To further minimise disruptions, construction vehicles will limit deliveries in school pick-up and drop-off times.
- Some noise is expected during this time.

We work carefully with the contractor to minimise potential impacts wherever possible. The contractor also works closely with the school to minimise any impacts on school activities.

Working hours

All works will take place between 7 am and 6 pm, Monday to Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise advised.



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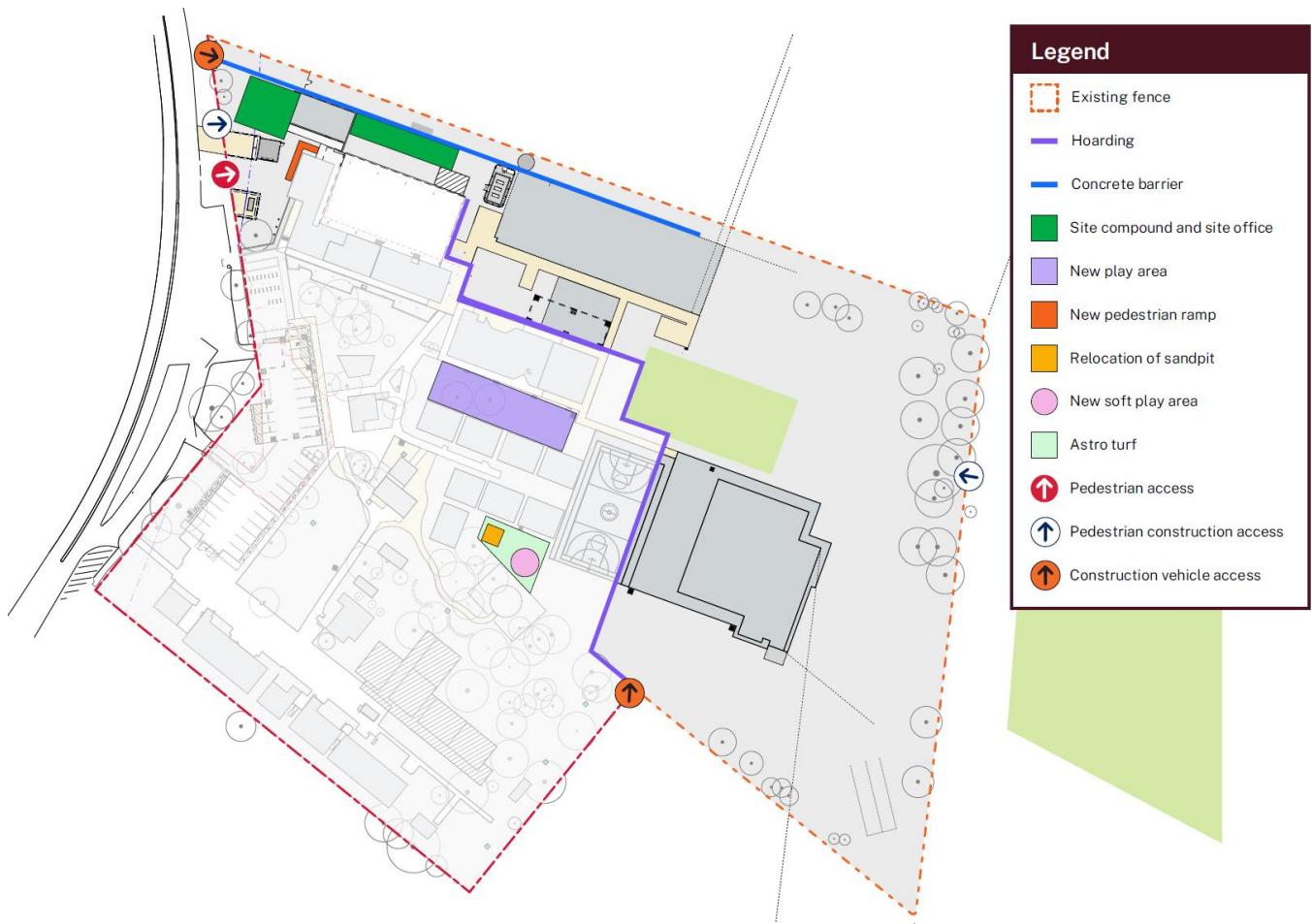
Managing construction impacts
