Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Lidcombe Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Lidcombe Public School to cater for forecast student growth in the area. This project will deliver a new two storey building with 14 flexible learning spaces and a new library. The existing library will be repurposed into two new flexible learning spaces.

Progress summary

The new administration building is completed and in use by the school.

Summer school holiday works

Over the summer school holidays, works will continue on the new two storey building, Block M. This includes external façade works, window installation, service connection and a continuation of the internal services fit out.

Construction work will take place Monday to Friday, 7:00am to 6:00pm, and Saturday 8:00am to 4:00pm. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

Traffic control and security measures will also be in place where required for the safety of the community.

School Infrastructure NSW will ensure this work is carried out safely and efficiently. During this time we will be working collaboratively with the school community and neighbours to ensure disruptions to the wider community are minimised.

Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

Over the summer school holidays, works will continue on the new two storey building, Block M. This includes external façade works, window installation, service connection, and a continuation of the internal services fit out.

What are the construction working hours?

Work hours will be from 7:00am to 6.00pm Monday to Friday, and 8:00am to 4:00pm on Saturdays. No works will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

Site works at Lidcombe Public School will stop at close of business on 20 December 2019 and resume on 6 January 2020.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing has been installed around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

In line with the Construction Management Plan, the contractor will continue to implement dust and noise control measures.

Dust and noise will be minimised through the use of hoarding and shade cloth. Dust will be controlled by spraying water during earth works whenever permissible under water-use restrictions.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers. Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
